

## PTA BYLAWS



The bylaws are the fundamental rules of your PTA.

Bylaws are updated every 3 years.

- To retain your charter and standards of affiliation with Maryland and National PTA
- To retain your PTA's 501(c)3 status
- To retain your PTA's incorporation status
- To vote at state and national convention
- To allow your students to participate in the PTA Reflections competition, awards and scholarships

## **BYLAWS REVISION PROCESS**

- 1. Establish a bylaws committee
- 2. Have the current PTA bylaws (need a copy? Email office@mdpta.org)
- 3. Get the new bylaws template by calling or emailing MD PTA at 410-760-6221 / email: office@mdpta.org

  The template is a fill in the blanks template. Cannot be done on the computer program.
- 4. Committee will review current bylaws and determine if changes are needed or not needed
- 5. **Read the instruction page** (*page 2*) **carefully**. Pay heed to #2 and #3 Note: any article has a # sign next to it, it may not be changed or moved
- 6. Committee will present proposed new bylaws to the Board of Directors Board will approve or send back to committee for revisions.
- 7. Set the general membership meeting date (30 days notice given) for the vote on the new bylaws by the general membership
- 8. Inform the general membership where a copy of the proposed bylaws draft can be found during this 30 day period
- 9. At the general membership meeting, establish quorum as written in your current bylaws in Article XI, Section 4. Vote on updated bylaws. Approval of bylaws and amendments requires a two-thirds vote of members present to be adopted
- 10. Sign and date bylaws
- 11. Make 3 copies of signed bylaws
- 12. -Send original + 2 copies with original signatures on each *plus the minutes from approval meeting* to MDPTA for their approval:

(It is suggested that originals to MDPTA be sent via certified return receipt mail)

-Keep a copy in secretary's files until approved bylaws are returned from MD PTA

- ♣ The timeframe for MD PTA bylaws committee approval could be a month or two.
