PTACHC Legislative Report for Feb. 6, 2017

The following 3 topics were addressed at the PTACHC January meeting either in a handout or in a presentation. Below are a few updates for your review on those topics and/or communicate your opinions to the various entities involved.

1. Maryland State Legislation (3 different bills) proposed to change how Howard County BOE members are elected. Currently, 7 BOE members are chosen countywide. Legislation has been proposed and is being considered during the current Maryland State Legislative Session (January – April 2017) that would change that. The public hearing for all local bills (i.e. bills that affect only Howard County) proposed by Howard County State Delegates and State Senators was held on Dec 21, 2016.

If Local bills are approved by a majority of the local State Senators and also the local State Delegates, then the bill goes on to the entire Maryland Legislature for typically a courtesy approval of local bills approved by the local Delegation.

2. Howard County Council / Planning Board -- APFO (Adequate Public Facilities Ordinance – a set of zoning regulations that test if there is enough infrastructure to proceed with or temporarily limit growth.)

3. Howard County Board of Education, Public Hearing for School Start Time/Dismissal Times, Tuesday, February 7, 2017 at 7pm.

At the January PTACHC meeting, a motion was made that PTACHC express support for continued discussion of new models for healthy start time options, but that the current 4 models that have been presented to us are unacceptable and therefore, we are supporting the current start time. Motion passed: 40 for motion, 8 against motion.
