Special Education



Friday, Oct. 1 marked the date when the majority bills that passed during the 2021 Legislative Session became law. While there may be several bills of interest, I bring your attention to HB 714 Special Education - Learning Continuity Plan – Requirement. This bill requires an individualized education program (IEP) to include a learning continuity plan to be implemented during emergency conditions, to ensure that the IEP is proceeding appropriately. What Does It Mean?

Ex-officio is a Latin term meaning "by virtue of office or position". Presidents serve as ex-officio members of all committees but do not count toward counting quorum or whether one is present. The president has the same rights as the other committee members but is not obligated to attend meetings of the committee. Additionally, presidents have the right to make motions, to speak in debate and to vote on all questions. However, presidents should remain impartial.
