

Digital Inclusion & Access To Learning

Bright Minds works to remove obstacles students face accessing their education. We help bridge the digital divide for students who lack access to technology and ensure students have the resources they need to fully participate in their education. We also provide emergency family stabilization support to students at risk of homelessness to ensure they can remain engaged in school.

Literacy & School Readiness


Bright Minds is the local affiliate for Dolly Parton's renowned Imagination Library. Our *Read With Me-Howard County* program mails participating children an age-appropriate book each month from birth through age five in order to build emergent literacy skills, inspire a love of reading, encourage parent-child interaction, and prepare children for kindergarten.

Classroom Innovation & Teacher Support

We provide grants to fund *Classroom Innovation Projects* that help educators deliver instructional projects that increase student learning outcomes, enrich teaching practices, strengthen school communities, and pilot important academic projects. Bright Minds is also the fiscal partner for the *HCPSS Teacher Externship Initiative*, which provides teachers workplace experience to complement academic knowledge.

College Access

Bright Minds helps students access and prepare for success in post-secondary education. We help high school students earn college credits and explore career options through the JumpStart dual-enrollment program with Howard Community College by providing books/course fee scholarships for students. We also administer third-party scholarships to make post-secondary education more accessible.
